Lifting import ban on poultry and poultry products from Province of British Columbia, Canada

According to the information from the Canadian Food Inspection Agency, the events of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza H5 Avian Influenza in Province of British Columbia, Canada have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from Province of British Columbia, Canada with effect from 10 June 2015.
