Lifting import ban on poultry and poultry products from South Africa except Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province

According to the information from the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries, the Avian Influenza incidents in South Africa **except Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province** have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from South Africa **except Western Cape Province and Eastern Cape Province** with effect from 22 March 2016.
