Import Suspension on Raw Oysters Produced by Huitres Geay in France Lifted

In connection with the previous food incidents concerning French raw oysters, the Centre for Food Safety (CFS) has suspended the import into Hong Kong of raw oysters produced by Huitres Geay in France since 29.12.2017.

In view of the submission of investigation report and the implementation of surveillance programme by the French authorities, CFS has conducted an assessment and decided to lift the import suspension imposed on raw oysters produced by Huitres Geay in France with immediate effect.

CFS will continue to monitor closely raw oysters imported from France. Appropriate actions will be taken to safeguard food safety and public health.
