<u>Lifting Import Suspension on Poultry and Poultry Products from Samara, Kursk, Penza, Smolensk, Oryol, Nizhny Novgorod, Rostov, Saratov, Voronezh, Ulyanovsk, Kostroma Oblasts; Republics of Chuvashia, Tatarstan, Udmurtia and Mari-El, Russia</u>

The Avian Influenza incidents in Samara, Kursk, Penza, Smolensk, Oryol, Nizhny Novgorod, Rostov, Saratov, Voronezh, Ulyanovsk, Kostroma Oblasts; Republics of Chuvashia, Tatarstan, Udmurtia and Mari-El, Russia have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import suspension on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the Samara, Kursk, Penza, Smolensk, Oryol, Nizhny Novgorod, Rostov, Saratov, Voronezh, Ulyanovsk, Kostroma Oblasts; Republics of Chuvashia, Tatarstan, Udmurtia and Mari-El, Russia with effect from 2 August 2019.
