Lifting import suspension on poultry and poultry products from areas in Poland

The Avian Influenza incidents in areas of Poland have been resolved. The Centre for Food Safety has lifted the import ban on poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from these areas in Poland with effect from 21 July 2020:

Wielkopolskie Region - Kolski District, Wolsztyn District, Koniński District;
Dolnoslaskie Region - Wrocławski District;
Warmińsko-Mazurskie Region - Ostródzki District;
Śląskie Region - Racibórz District;
Opolskie Region - Kedzierzynsko-kozielski District; and
Łódzkie Region - Sieradzki District, Lowicki District, Lodzki Wschodni District,
Poddebicki District, Zgierski District, The City of Łódź, Pabianicki District.
