Resumption of import of poultry and poultry products from Stanislaus County, State of California, the United States

In view of effective measures taken by the American authority against Avian Influenza in Stanislaus County, State of California, the United States, Avian Influenza in the county was resolved. The Centre for Food Safety (Centre) has resumed import of poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from the county since 10 October 2014.

As there was previous outbreak of Avian Influenza in Stanislaus County, State of California, the United States, the Centre had banned import of poultry and poultry products (including poultry eggs) from this county for protection of public health in Hong Kong.
