Media reported the French Health authority had ordered Nestle in France to destroy all Perrier production from 10 to 14 March 2024
	from one of its seven water extraction sites in southern France due to suspected contamination from fecal origin (coliforms, Escherichia coli) and Pseudomonas aeruginosa. According to Nestlé, this situation is the consequence of heavy rainfall during storm Monica, which hit the region in March 2024.
Position of CFS	 Information on product distribution outside France is not available at the time. CFS is investigating whether the affected batch has been imported to Hong Kong. Preliminary investigation so far does not identify local sale of the affected product. Acquisition of the products through online purchase or international travel cannot be excluded. Consumers should discard the affected products and not consume them. CFS will remain vigilant and monitor for any new development and take appropriate actions when necessary. Investigation by CFS is ongoing.
